
On June 25, 2015, this court suspended respondent, Rodger William Moore, from the practice of law for a period of two years with the second year stayed on the conditions that he (1) comply with the terms of his contract with the Ohio Lawyer's Assistance Program ("OLAP"), (2) provide relator and OLAP with evidence of regular counseling visits with his psychologist and periodic reports from that psychologist, and (3) commit no further misconduct. The court further ordered that respondent immediately cease and desist from the practice of law in any form.

On September 16, 2016, relator, the Cincinnati Bar Association, filed a motion to hold respondent in contempt, alleging that he has continued to practice law after this court's June 25, 2015 suspension order. On September 26, 2016, respondent filed a response to relator's contempt motion.

Upon consideration thereof, it is ordered and adjudged by this court that respondent, Rodger William Moore, Attorney Registration No. 0074144, last known address in Fort Mitchell, Kentucky, is found in contempt for failure to comply with the court's June 25, 2015 order. It is further ordered that the previously imposed one-year stay of the suspension is revoked and that respondent shall serve the entire two-year suspension imposed on June 25, 2015.

It is further ordered that service shall be deemed made on respondent by sending this order, and all other orders in this case, by certified mail to respondent's last known address.

It is further ordered that the clerk of this court issue certified copies of this order as provided for in Gov.Bar R.V(17)(D)(1) and that publication be made as provided for in Gov.Bar R.V(17)(D)(2).
