

PLAINTIFFS FIRST REQUEST FOR PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS,
TRANSCRIPTS

Pursuant to Civil Rule 34, Plaintiff hereby request that respondent/
defendant produce for inspection and copying the following documents or items
which are in the defendant's possession, custody, or control, or that of
its Attorneys agents, or representatives. In case at bar the items will have
to be mailed to Plaintiff/Relator at Andre Yeager 432928, P.O. Box 788,
Mansfield, Ohio 44901.

As used herein, "document" means any medium upon which intelligence or information is recorded or from which intelligence or information can be recorded, retrieved, or perceived, including, but not limited to notes, letters, memorandums, transcripts.

On July 8, 2005, State Prosecutor, Philip Bogdanoff, submitted a motion to supplement record, to the Ninth District Court pursuant to appellate rule 9(E) "the state requests to supplement the record in this case, with the record of the defendant's prior case, State v. Yeager, Summit No.21091, 2112, 21120. The State contends the defendant's prior to trial transcripts included in this record are relevant to determine whether the defendant properly waived his right to counsel". (See, Attached)


Andre Yeager, personally does not know which transcripts in particular counsel wished to supplement with but, in the interest of justice, to once and for all resolve the matter of waiver of counsel, lets place it all on the table, counsel is reaching because in February 2002, 2 or 3 times I requested in open Court to defend myself, although his motion was denied by the Court of Appeals and Philip Bogdanoff is not a party under Civil rules 26(B) and 45(F) a person not a party to the action may be compelled to produce documents of tangible things or to submit to an inspection as provided in Civil Rule 45:

- 5) All audio recordings also that was being taken in Judge Williams Court on the above dates.


