





1. I was an attorney licensed by the State of Ohio.
2. In April, 2006, I submitted an affidavit of resignation of my license to practice law to the Supreme Court of Ohio.
3. At the time of the submission of the Affidavit of Resignation, I had only one client and was representing that client solely in the Court of Common Pleas, Juvenile Division in Lake County, Ohio.
