

Derek A. Farmer hereby provides this Affidavit in compliance with the Supreme Court of Ohio order dated November 1, 2006.


Derek A. Farmer, first being duly sworn under oath, states as follows:


8. I have maintained copies of all the mail sent out to satisfy this order.


**ORDER OF SUSPENSION**

A copy of this Order shall be served upon Derek A. Farmer via certified mail, return receipt requested.


