

RE: Response on Invitation to Resign

Dear Mrs. Grosko:

As I am sure you have determined from my filing a 203 page Writ of Mandamus yesterday, December 12, 2006, I am unwilling to resign from the practice of law. I appreciate your assistance yesterday, as well as that of the very nice person from the clerk's office who assisted me. I have been most impressed with the clerk's office at the Ohio Supreme Court.

Instead of resigning, I am demanding substantial declaratory relief, substantial damages, and substantial action taken against the corrupt chief ethics commission lawyers who have stolen my bank records, stolen my attorney fees, filed fraudulent charges, written a blatantly dishonest and retaliatory opinion, stolen my law license, and destroyed my business and life with this corrupt government regulation.
