ORDER

The Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline filed its Final Report in this court on June 20, 2006, recommending that pursuant to Rule V(6)(B)(1) of the Supreme Court Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio the respondent, Curtis Griffith, Jr., be permanently disbarred from the practice of law. Respondent filed no objections to said Final Report, and this cause was considered by the court. On consideration thereof,

It is ordered and adjudged by this court that pursuant to Gov.Bar R. V(6)(B)(1), respondent, Curtis Griffith, Jr., Attorney Registration Number 0030707, last known business address in New Lexington, Ohio, be permanently disbarred from the practice of law consistent with the opinion rendered herein.

It is further ordered that respondent immediately cease and desist from the practice of law in any form and is hereby forbidden to appear on behalf of another before any court, judge, commission, board, administrative agency or other public authority.

It is further ordered that respondent is hereby forbidden to counsel or advise or prepare legal instruments for others or in any manner perform such services.

It is further ordered that respondent is hereby divested of each, any and all of the rights, privileges and prerogatives customarily accorded to a member in good standing of the legal profession of Ohio.

It is further ordered that respondent surrender respondent's certificate of admission to practice to the clerk of the court on or before 30 days from the date of this order, and that respondent's name be stricken from the roll of attorneys maintained by this court.

It is further ordered that respondent be taxed the costs of these proceedings in the amount of One Hundred Forty Dollars and Nine Cents (\$140.09), which costs shall be payable to this court by certified check or money order on or before 90 days from the date of this order. It is further ordered that if these costs are not paid in full on or before 90 days from the date of this order, interest at the rate of 10% per annum shall accrue as

7. Retain and maintain a record of the various steps taken by respondent pursuant to this order.

It is further ordered that until such time as respondent fully complies with this order, respondent shall keep the Clerk, and the Disciplinary Counsel advised of any change of address where respondent may receive communications.

It is further ordered, sua sponte, that all documents filed with this court in this case shall meet the filing requirements set forth in the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio, including requirements as to form, number, and timeliness of filings.

It is further ordered, sua sponte, that service shall be deemed made on respondent by sending this order, and all other orders in this case, by certified mail to the most recent address respondent has given to the Attorney Registration Section.

It is further ordered that the clerk of this court issue certified copies of this order as provided for in Gov.Bar R. V(8)(D)(1), that publication be made as provided for in Gov.Bar R. V(8)(D)(2), and that respondent bear the costs of publication.
