

CLAIM DETERMINATION ENTRY

In Re Application of **Prentis Rucker, Jr. vs. John Lord**
CSF Claim No. 05-0138

This cause came on for hearing before the Board of Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund this 2nd of March, 2007 on the application of **Prentis Rucker, Jr.** alleging a loss in the amount of \$795.00, caused by dishonest conduct of an attorney duly licensed to practice in the State of Ohio

The Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund of Ohio find that:

- a) An attorney client relationship did exist between the claimant and **John Lord.**
- b) The claimant suffered a loss of \$750.00 on or about January, 2005.

The Commissioners further find that the dishonest conduct consisted of **unearned/unreturned legal fees**, and that the following disciplinary proceedings were taken:

Indefinite Suspension, 11/1/06

The Commissioners further find that the claimant took affirmative action against the attorney within one year of becoming aware of the loss; and that there is no insurance or bond which will benefit the claimant; and that said claimant is not a spouse, close relative, partner, insurer or bonding company, nor a governmental unit.

Therefore the Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund do hereby determine that the claim of **Prentis Rucker, Jr.** is eligible for reimbursement in the amount of **\$750.00.**

Payment of said amount is conditioned upon claimant complying with the subrogation assignment and other requirements of Sec. 6 of GOV. Rule VIII of the Ohio Supreme Court.
