



**MOTION OF CAROLE R. SQUIRE FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE  
OBJECTIONS TO FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND  
RECOMMENDATION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ON  
GRIEVANCES AND DISCIPLINE OF THE SUPREME COURT OF OHIO**

This is to request an extension of time beyond April 27, 2007, to respond to the Findings of Fact in this matter. This additional extension is requested for the reason following eight days of hearing, the Board and Disciplinary Counsel took five months to publish over 80 pages of findings of fact and conclusions of law. 
