NOTICE OF ORAL ARGUMENT

The Supreme Court of Ohio will hold an oral argument on the merits in this case on Wednesday, October 10, 2007, in Judge Hein's courtroom, on the second floor of the Darke County Courthouse, 504 South Broadway, Greenville, Ohio. Time allowed for oral argument will be 15 minutes per side.

Attorneys who argue before the Court must comply with the provisions of Rule IX of the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and the instructions that follow. Pursuant to Rule IX, Section 3, counsel for either or both parties may waive oral argument and submit the case upon briefs. The Clerk must be notified in writing of the waiver at least ten days before the date scheduled for the oral argument.

Court convenes promptly at 9 a.m. Counsel in all cases are expected to be present when court convenes. Counsel must register **prior to 8:45 a.m.** in Magistrate Brumbaugh's office on the second floor of the Darke County Courthouse.
