




Now comes Appellant-Relator, Margarita Glenn, and hereby requests this Court to hold oral arguments on the action. This request is made pursuant to S. Ct. Prac. R. IX, Section 2.

The issues before this Court involve matters of extreme importance to the injured workers' of Ohio under the Workers' Compensation Act. The current practice of the Bureau of Workers' Compensation, sanctioned by the Industrial Commission of Ohio's misinterpretation of this Court's precedent, results in claimant's having been found to voluntarily abandon the workforce, and thus lose all entitlement to disability benefits. This practice defeats the purposes of the Workers' Compensation Act and the Constitution of Ohio, Section 35, Article II.

In addition, oral argument will help clarify the issues for this Court.


