



In addition the realtor asserts that the filing fee of \$75.00 was paid by cashier's check to the Hamilton County Board of Elections. The payment was made through the United States Postal Service, via overnight express mail systems. The overnight express mail systems package was delivered at 9:28 a.m. on 8/30/07 to the Hamilton County Board of Elections at 824 Broadway, Cincinnati, Ohio 45202. The overnight express mail systems package was signed for by H. Tribble; has tracking number #EB 362928371 US.

The realtor Yvette Barbara Baldwin asserts that the signature by H. Tribble engages, obligates and binds the Hamilton County Board of Elections by written signature to declare that the nominating petition signatures for Yvette Barbara Baldwin were received in a timely manner and recorded as public record as required by law. The realtor Yvette Barbara Baldwin asserts that she has not been listed on the ballot as a City of Cincinnati City Council Candidate, for the general election to be held on November 6th, 2007. The realtor Yvette Barbara Baldwin requests that the Ohio Supreme Court critically review, evaluate, analyze, and resolve this original complaint and present as public record the approximately 925 nominating petition signatures submitted by Yvette Barbara Baldwin.

The realtor Yvette Barbara Baldwin asserts that she has not been advised as to whether or not the 925 nominating petition signatures included at least 500 valid nominating petition signatures. The realtor Yvette Barbara Baldwin advises that she has learned through hearsay based on rumors and public gossip that the reasoning for the realtor Yvette Barbara Baldwin not being listed as a viable Candidate for the 2007 City of Cincinnati Council race; is strictly due to the will of the people based on negative rumors spread amongst the citizens degrading the realtor Yvette Barbara Baldwin and her character; all of which the realtor Yvette Barbara Baldwin denies.

The realtor further asserts that she is an international sworn-in public official; has previously performed duties as a sworn-in notary public official for the State of Ohio; currently serves as a sworn-in notary public official for the State of Ohio and as a sworn-in public official for the Hamilton County Clerk of Courts.


Candidates file to run in November

The filing deadline is up, and the Hamilton County Board of Elections released the unofficial list of candidates who've filed petitions to run for local office in the general election Tuesday, Nov. 6.

In Green Township, incumbent Trustee Tony Upton will be running to keep his seat against challengers Tom Pfahler and Dale J. Rack. Green Township Fiscal Officer Tom Straus is running unopposed to retain his seat.

Cheviot Mayor Samuel D. Keller (D) will run against Matthew D. McGowan (R), who right now serves as clerk of council, for another four-year term as mayor.



Recently appointed City Council President Deborah M. McKinney (R) will run against former council president James E. Morganroth (D) to determine who will fill an unexpired term ending in December 2009.

The battle for Cheviot Auditor will be between Linda Calambas (R) and Theresa Ciolino-Klein (D). Cheviot Law Director Mark G. Waters is running unopposed to keep his seat for another four years.

Current at-large Council members Steven L. Braun, Charles Norman and Kathleen Zech, all of whom are Republicans, are being challenged by Ward 2 Councilman Dennis T. Dinkelacker, Ward 3 Councilman James F. Sunderhaus and former councilman Michael J. Murray. All three challengers are Democrats.

In area board of education races, incumbent Oak Hills School Board member Janice C. Hunter, Ben Clinkenbeard and Steven P. Schinkal are the three candidates vying for two open seats on the Oak Hills Board of Education.
