




**NOTICE OF APPEAL**

Defendant-Appellant Jermaine Baker now gives notice of appeal to this Honorable Court of a Claimed Appeal of Right of the Ninth District Court of Appeals opinion, *State v. Jermaine Baker*, Summit App. 23840, Summit trial court case 2007-01-0186(A), involving his felony convictions and 32 year sentence.
