


NOTICE OF APPEAL

Defendant-Appellant Robert Egli now gives notice of this claimed appeal of right of the Eleventh District Court of Appeals opinion, State v. Egli, Portage Appeal Number 2007-P-0052, Trial Court Case 2006 CR 0666, a case involving a felony conviction that also concerns substantial constitutional questions.

On May 27, 2008, the Eleventh District in State v.
