Dear Mr. Amourgis:

On March 21, 2007, the Supreme Court of Ohio suspended you for a period of twelve months, stayed the entire suspension, and placed you on probation. On July 3, 2008, you filed an application for termination of probation.

The Supreme Court of Ohio has informed the Clerk's Office that it will not consider termination of an attorney's probation until the Court's orders and Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio have been fully complied with and the requirements for reinstatement have been met.

The Court will not consider your application for termination of probation because of the following reason:


You were ordered by the Court in its March 21, 2007, order to comply with the Rules for the Government of Ohio. The Commission on Continuing Legal Education ("Commission") has indicated that you are not in compliance with Gov.Bar R. X for the 2006/2007 reporting period. For your convenience, enclosed is a copy of the July 21, 2008, letter from the Commission.

The Supreme Court will not consider your reinstatement until such time as you comply with Gov. Bar R. X and you file with the Clerk's Office written documentation demonstrating your compliance with this rule.

Note that all documents filed with the Supreme Court in this case, including documents regarding your compliance with Gov. Bar R. X, must meet the filing requirements set forth in the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court, including requirements as to form, number, and timeliness of filings.

This is in response to your July 11, 2008 letter regarding whether Julius P. Amourgis, (attorney registration number 0069140) is in compliance with provision of Rule X.

A review of Mr. Amourgis' record of continuing legal education indicates for the 2006-2007 reporting period, Mr. Amourgis is not in compliance. Specifically, he was deficient .50 hour of substance abuse instruction. The records indicate that Mr. Amourgis has not submitted evidence of compliance during the late compliance period.
