




CLAIM DETERMINATION ENTRY

In Re Application of John A. Benson vs. Darrell Vernon Van Horn
Claim Number 07-0099

This cause came on for hearing before the Board of Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund this 5th of September, 2008 on the application of John A. Benson alleging a loss in the amount of \$3,393.00, caused by dishonest conduct of an attorney duly licensed to practice in the State of Ohio

The Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund of Ohio find that:

- a) An attorney client relationship did exist between the claimant and Darrell Vernon Van Horn.
- b) The claimant suffered a loss of \$3,393.00 on or about on or about March 23, 2006.

The Commissioners further find that the dishonest conduct consisted of settlement theft, and that the following disciplinary proceedings were taken:


Suspended Indefinitely on 3/21/2007

The Commissioners further find that the claimant took affirmative action against the attorney within one year of becoming aware of the loss; and that there is no insurance or bond which will benefit the claimant; and that said claimant is not a spouse, close relative, partner, insurer or bonding company, nor a governmental unit.

Therefore the Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund do hereby determine that the claim of John A. Benson is eligible for reimbursement in the amount of \$3,393.00.

Payment of said amount is conditioned upon claimant complying with the subrogation assignment and other requirements of Sec. 6 of GOV. Rule VIII of the Ohio Supreme Court.
