



**CLAIM DETERMINATION ENTRY**

In Re Application of Vernon R. Martin vs. Joseph Eugene Marosan  
Claim Number 06-0214

This cause came on for hearing before the Board of Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund this 5<sup>th</sup> of September, 2008 on the application of Vernon R. Martin alleging a loss in the amount of \$15,294.05, caused by dishonest conduct of an attorney duly licensed to practice in the State of Ohio

The Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund of Ohio find that:

- a) An attorney client relationship did exist between the claimant and Joseph Eugene Marosan.
- b) The claimant suffered a loss of \$15,294.05.00 on or about October, 2006.

The Commissioners further find that the dishonest conduct consisted of fiduciary, and that the following disciplinary proceedings were taken:

DISBARRED on 8/7/2008

The Commissioners further find that the claimant took affirmative action against the attorney within one year of becoming aware of the loss; and that there is no insurance or bond which will benefit the claimant; and that said claimant is not a spouse, close relative, partner, insurer or bonding company, nor a governmental unit.

Therefore the Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund do hereby determine that the claim of Vernon R. Martin is eligible for reimbursement in the amount of \$15,294.05.

Payment of said amount is conditioned upon claimant complying with the subrogation assignment and other requirements of Sec. 6 of GOV. Rule VIII of the Ohio Supreme Court.
