



Now come the Debtors, Harold and Diane Miller, by and through Counsel, who respectfully request the Court to issue an order modifying their Chapter 13 Plan to provide that the Chapter 13 Plan payments be modified starting November 2008 to \$1,250.00 per month until the completion of the plan and that the dividend paid to unsecured creditors be lowered from 84% to 0%.

MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF MOTION

The Debtors' Chapter 13 Plan was confirmed by Court Order dated July 14, 2008. There have been no previous modifications filed.

Since the onset of the case, the Debtors have experienced changes in income and expenses and are currently unable to afford the plan payment of \$1,800.00 per month. In addition, the Debtors have been served with a pre-petition civil penalty in the amount of \$7,500.00 from the Supreme Court of Ohio. The addition of said debt to the Debtors' Chapter 13 Plan has caused the plan to project to complete beyond the sixty months allowed by law. The Debtors are proposing to cure the length problem by modifying their Chapter 13 Plan payments to \$1,250.00 per month starting in November 2008 and by lowering the dividend paid to unsecured creditors from 84% to 0%.

The Debtors propose to pay the debts as follows:

1. The Administrative Priority Claim for attorney fees owed to Debtors' counsel shall be paid \$625.00 per month (starting Nov. 2008) until paid in full (estimated to be 3 months);
2. American General for the second mortgage shall be paid \$340.00 per month for 3 months (starting Nov. 2008); then \$620.00 per month until paid in full; The claim shall be paid at 10% interest;
3. HSBC Auto Finance for the 2003 Mitsubishi Galant shall be paid \$100.00 per month for 3 months (starting Nov. 2008); then \$250.00 per month until paid in full; The claim shall be paid at 3.9% interest;
4. Dell Financial for the computer shall be paid \$40.00 per month (starting Nov. 2008) until paid in full; The claim shall be paid at 6% interest;
5. The claim of Citifinancial for the 2002 Hyundai Elantra shall be paid \$100.00 per month for 3 months (starting Nov. 2008); then \$300.00 per month until paid in full; The claim shall be paid at 6% interest;
6. The priority debt owed to the Supreme Court of Ohio for the Civil Penalty shall be paid in full;
7. After the above mentioned claims have been paid, the arrearage claim of Countrywide Home Loans shall be paid in full;

8. The unsecured claims shall then be paid a total of \$0 or 0%. The plan shall last no longer than 60 months.

The Plan, as modified, meets the best interest of creditors test as well as completes within sixty (60) months from plan confirmation.

WHEREFORE, the Debtors respectfully request the Court to issue an order modifying their plan to provide that the Chapter 13 Plan payments be modified starting November 2008 to \$1,250.00 per month until the completion of the plan and the dividend paid to unsecured creditors be lowered from 84% to 0%.
