Dear Mr. Bowman:

On August 23, 2006, the Supreme Court of Ohio suspended you for a period of two years, with conditions. You filed an application for reinstatement on December 23, 2008. The Supreme Court of Ohio has informed the Clerk's Office that it will not consider an attorney's application for reinstatement until the court's orders and the Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio have been fully complied with and the requirements for reinstatement have been met.


The court will not consider your application for reinstatement for the following reason. In its order of August 23, 2006, the court ordered you to complete one credit hour of continuing legal education for each month, or portion of a month, of suspension. The court further ordered that, as part of the total credit hours of continuing legal education required by Gov.Bar R. X(3)(G), you shall complete one credit hour of instruction related to professional conduct required by Gov.Bar R. X(3)(A)(1), for each six months or portion of six months, of suspension.

When you filed your application for reinstatement on December 23, 2008, you needed to have completed a total of 28 hours of CLE, including five hours related to professional conduct as required by Gov.Bar R. X(3)(A)(1). The attached letter and transcript from the Commission on Continuing Legal Education indicates that since August 23, 2006, you have reported 20 CLE hours which includes 5.5 hours related to professional conduct.

If you believe the information provided by the commission is inaccurate, please contact that office to resolve the matter. You may file additional documentation to support your compliance with this portion of the court's order. Note that all documents filed with the court in this case must meet the filing requirements set forth in the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court. Once you have filed documentation of your full compliance with the court's order, this office will contact the commission to confirm your reported attendance.


