

**MOTION FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF
THE OFFICE OF THE OHIO PUBLIC DEFENDER AS COUNSEL**

Richard L. Underwood, Jr. moves this Court to appoint the Office of the Ohio Public Defender as counsel in the above-captioned case. This Court has accepted the State's appeal as a certified conflict in case no. 2008-2228, as well as Propositions I and II contained in the State's Memorandum in Support of Jurisdiction in case no. 2008-2133. (January 28, 2009 Decision). This Court has also consolidated the above cases. The consolidated case involves a felony, and Mr. Underwood is indigent. Mr. Underwood's Affidavit of Indigency is attached to this motion. Supreme Court Practice Rule III, Section 7 states that:

If the Supreme Court grants leave to appeal in a discretionary appeal involving a felony and an unrepresented party to the appeal is indigent, the Supreme Court will appoint the Ohio Public Defender or other counsel to represent the indigent party or order the court of appeals to appoint counsel as provided in S. Ct. Prac. R. II, Section 2(D)(2).

In accordance with S. Ct. Prac. R. III, Section 7, Mr. Underwood requests that this Court appoint the Office of the Ohio Public Defender as counsel in the above-captioned case.


