

MOTION FOR ADMISSION PRO HAC VICE OF MICHAEL S. STEIN





Michael S. Stein, one of 29 distinguished 2007 Skadden Fellows, began as staff attorney for the National Association of the Deaf (NAD) Law and Advocacy Center in September 2007. His work for the NAD focuses on increasing accessibility of medical and legal services for deaf and hard of hearing people.

The Skadden Fellowship Foundation was established in 1988 to commemorate the firm's 40th anniversary, in recognition of the need for greater funding for graduating law students who wish to devote their professional lives to providing legal services to the unrepresented and underrepresented.

A native of Maplewood, New Jersey, Stein graduated from Princeton in 2003 and from Harvard Law School in 2006. At Harvard Law School, he was Notes Editor of the Harvard Law Review and published a comment on captioning in movie theaters.

He worked as a student advocate at the Hale and Dorr Legal Services Center representing clients on Social Security and housing issues. Stein also spent his summers as an intern at the U.S. Department of Justice and as a summer associate at the Covington & Burling law firm in New York.

After graduating from Harvard Law School, Stein clerked for the Honorable William G. Young in the United States District Court for the District of Massachusetts.
