

MOTION FOR ADMISSION PRO HAC VICE OF ROSALINE HAYES CRAWFORD





Rosaline Hayes Crawford

Director, Law and Advocacy Center

Rosaline Crawford joined the NAD Law and Advocacy Center as an attorney in September 2002 and became its director in 2007. She provides information and technical assistance to individuals and service providers on the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, the Americans with Disabilities Act, the Fair Housing Act, the Telecommunications Act, and other disability-related laws.

Crawford receives and responds to hundreds of requests every month for information about the legal rights of deaf and hard of hearing people and information about the laws that prohibit disability discrimination. She educates, advocates on behalf of, and seeks to empower deaf and hard of hearing people. In addition, she represents deaf and hard of hearing people in select cases covering a broad range of disability discrimination issues in a variety of contexts. Crawford also represents the NAD at conferences, in disability rights coalitions, at advisory council meetings, and before federal agencies.

From 1970 to 1988, she was engaged in administrative support, sales, and management in publishing, insurance, hotel guest services, and conferences. Crawford traveled extensively throughout the United States and Europe. In 1988, she relocated to the Washington, DC, metropolitan area. From 1988 to 2001, she was an assistant and paralegal in the Office of General Counsel at The Catholic University of America.

Crawford completed her paralegal studies program at the University of Maryland, University College, in 1993 and received a Bachelor of Arts degree from The Catholic University of America in 2000. She earned her Juris Doctor degree from the Columbus School of Law and was admitted to the Maryland Bar in 2002.
