

4. On March 30, 2009, Respondent filed with the clerk of this Court and with Disciplinary Counsel an affidavit of compliance, demonstrating that if necessary he had properly notified the following of the fact of his suspension: all clients, any co-counsel, any opposing counsel, and any courts or tribunals before which cases were pending and in which Respondent was counsel or co-counsel at the time of his suspension.

5. Further, at the time of his suspension, respondent did not have any clients, papers or property of any clients, or any unearned fees.

6. Respondent surrendered his attorney registration card on November 26, 2007.

7. Respondent maintained records of the various steps taken to comply with this Court's October 10, 2007 suspension order.

8. On December 10, 2007, Respondent paid \$1,000.00 to the Clerk of the Mount Vernon Municipal Court, which represented the costs ordered to be paid within 60 days of the order, a copy of the paid invoice was previously filed with this Court.

9. On January 9, 2008, Respondent paid \$2,084.97 to the Clerk of this Court, evidenced by receipt #1586451, which represented the costs ordered to be paid within 90 days of the order.

10. On October 22, 2008, Respondent paid to the Clerk of this Court \$51.47, evidenced by receipt #1586562, which represented publication costs of \$49.41 which were ordered to be paid within 90 days of June 2, 2008, \$.50 in interest, and an over payment of \$1.56.

11. On March 30, 2009, Respondent paid \$248.60 to the Clerk of the Mount Vernon Municipal Court, which represented interest on the costs previously paid to that court from the date of the original awards until the costs were paid on December 8, 2007, a copy of the paid invoice was previously filed with this Court.

12. No formal disciplinary proceedings are presently pending against Respondent.

13. During the period of the ordered suspension, Respondent refrained from counseling; rendering advice, or preparing legal instruments for others.

14. As evidenced by the transcript available on this Court's web site, supplemented by the attached exhibits, Respondent has completed one credit hour of continuing legal education for each month or portion of a month of his suspension, including one credit hour of instruction related to professional conduct, for each six months, or portion of six months, of the suspension.

15. Respondent has received no notification of any awards against Respondent by the Client Security Fund.

16. Respondent believes that he has otherwise complied with the requirements for reinstatement set forth in this Court's Rules for the Government of the Bar, and Respondent has complied with the Court's October 10, 2007 suspension order.

WHEREFORE, having fully complied with this Court's October 10, 2007 suspension order; having served the suspension, and otherwise having satisfied the conditions for reinstatement, Respondent prays for order of this Court granting him reinstatement to the practice of law.


