
Dear Ms. Christoff:

P. Robert Broeren (attorney registration number 0069166) filed an Application for Reinstatement with this Court, pursuant to Gov.Bar R. V(10)(A). According to the Supreme Court's Order dated October 10, 2007, Mr. Broeren was suspended from the practice of law for a period of six months. See, *Disciplinary Counsel v. Broeren*, 115 Ohio St.3d 473, 2007-Ohio-5251.

The Court's disciplinary order directed the respondent to comply with the continuing legal education requirements of Gov.Bar R. X(3)(G). Could you please inform me whether Mr. has received any credit for continuing legal education hours since October 10, 2007? I would appreciate it if you would also inform me if any of the CLE hours related to professional conduct.
