
Dear Mr. Marshall:

On April 28, 2009, George Matthew Parker filed an Application for Reinstatement with this Court. Mr. Parker was suspended from the practice of law on October 25, 2007, for a period of eighteen months with six months stayed on conditions. See, *Disciplinary Counsel v. Parker*, 116 Ohio St.3d 64, 2007-Ohio-5635.

Gov.Bar R. V(10)(A) permits an Application for Reinstatement at the expiration of the period of suspension, provided, among other things, there are no formal disciplinary proceedings currently pending against the applicant. The purpose of this letter is to request written verification that there are no formal disciplinary proceedings pending against Mr. Parker before the Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline.
