The Respondent is now and has been unaware of the proceedings. Respondent was made aware of a Complaint in 2008, responded to same and made the Relator aware That he was unable to attend any proceedings or hearings in Dayton. It was due to his being in an alcohol rehabilitation center/ half way house. The Respondent spent one year at this facility. Respondent has Not been in the State of Ohio nor has he practiced law for two years. Respondent would like the opportunity to respond if he knew what the allegations are in the above referenced matter. As an offer in compromise, Respondent has elected to go inactive in the Certificate Of Registration for the 2009-2011 Biennium and intends to remain

Inactive. The Office of Attorney Services is aware of Respondent's Current mailing address of 214 East 15th Street, Jasper, Indiana 47546. Respondent intends to remain in Indiana until relocating to Florida. In all cases, Respondent intends to remain inactive from the practice of law. His continued sobriety is much more important than engaging in the practice again. It is prayed however that he not be indefinitely Suspended. Respondent has had an exemplary record of practice as a Public Defender in Montgomery County, Ohio and later in private practice and this is the first disciplinary action ever taken against him. Respondent is in fact indigent at this time, however if made aware of the amount of costs associated with this action, he will comply with an Order to pay.

CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS 2009/2011 BIENNIUM

Rule VI of the Supreme Court Rules for the Government of the Bar requires attorneys admitted to and engaged in the practice of law in Ohio to register biennially with the Supreme Court. The 2009/2011 biennium begins Sept. 1, 2009, and continues through Aug. 31, 2011. Enclosed are your Certificate of Registration and a return envelope. The complete text of Rule VI of the Supreme Court Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio is available at supremecourt.ohio.gov/LegalResources/Rules/govbar/govbar.pdf.

NEW THIS BIENNIUM

1. The late registration period for attorneys failing to register by the Sept. 1, 2009, deadline has been shortened from 90 to 60 days. Attorneys who do not register during the 60-day late registration period will be summarily suspended from the practice of law. See, Gov. Bar R. VI, Section 5(B).

SUBMITTING YOUR REGISTRATION MATERIALS

Electronic Registration

You may use electronic registration to register and pay your registration fees, review and update your contact information, and report your IOLTA or IOTA information. Follow these steps to register online:

1. Go to the Online Attorney Services site at <https://www.supremecourt.ohio.gov/ASW/>
2. To log in
 - Provide your attorney registration number and your password. If you do not have a password, go to supremecourt.ohio.gov/ASW/ASWPRequest.aspx.
 - Provide an e-mail address.
3. Review your personal information in My Information.
4. Go to **Modify Information** to update or modify your personal information.
5. Go to **Register Online** and report your IOLTA status and, if applicable, your account information.
6. Select 2009/2011 on the "select biennium" drop-down box.
7. Select the status for which you are registering on the "select new status" drop-down box.
8. If you owe a registration fee and/or a late fee, submit your payment by credit card (MasterCard or VISA only) to complete the registration transaction.
9. After you complete your registration, you will receive online confirmation of your registration as well as written confirmation in the mail within two weeks.
10. To avoid a \$50 late fee, online registrations must be received by no later than 11:59 p.m., Eastern Daylight Time, Sept. 1, 2009. Do not wait until the last minute to register. By doing so, you assume all risk that the online site may not be available and you may not be able to complete your registration by the deadline. Inability to use the site shall not be an excuse for failure to file your registration timely.

1. Review the enclosed Certificate of Registration. Print or type any missing information. To make corrections, mark a single line through incorrect information and print or type corrections directly above.


