RELATOR, DIONDRAY BEAL'S MOTION TO AMEND MANDAMUS

Now comes Diondray Beal, pro se, to request leave to amend his Mandamus filed in this Court on June 26, 2009, for the following reasons. Memorandum In support follows;

MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

The relator, Diondray Beal, filed a Mandamus with this Court on 26 June 2009, for the non-response by the Second appellate District Court of Appeals. The Relator is incarcerated, indigent, and has no outside support. The law library is used by the 2000 inmates, and has a policy limiting the time to twenty minutes for use of the library instruments. This severely hinders the Relators ability to research, produce and file legal actions. he has despite that, acted in good faith. He respectfully request that he be allowed to Amend his Mandamus filed 26 June 2009. he has no other means of relief. The error stated by the Respondent, are minor technicalities, that the relator has rectified in his amended mandamus and the Reply Brief . The Respondent suffers no prejudice if the Court grants leave to amend.

CONCLUSION

(The Relators Mandamus and Appeals will suffer irreparable harm if the Motion is not granted. He has no other means of relief, and for reasons unknown, the Appellate Court has not responded to his supplemental brief in any way (See Relators Reply Brief).
