CLAIM DETERMINATION ENTRY

In Re Application of Otis Shackelford, Individually and the Estate of Patsy Shackelford vs. Kenneth Levon Lawson, Claim No. 08-0009

This cause came on for hearing before the Board of Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund this 28th day of August, 2009 on the application of Otis Shackelford, Individually and the Estate of Patsy Shackelford alleging a loss in the amount of \$20,500.00, caused by dishonest conduct of an attorney duly licensed to practice in the State of Ohio

The Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund of Ohio find that:

- a) An attorney client relationship did exist between the claimant and Kenneth Levon Lawson.
- b) The claimant suffered a loss of \$8,500.00 on or about after June 7, 2004.

The Commissioners further find that the dishonest conduct consisted of theft of unearned fees, and that the following disciplinary proceedings were taken:

Felony Suspension on 7/31/2009

The Commissioners further find that the claimant took affirmative action against the attorney within one year of becoming aware of the loss; and that there is no insurance or bond which will benefit the claimant; and that said claimant is not a spouse, close relative, partner, insurer or bonding company, nor a governmental unit.

Therefore the Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund do hereby determine that the claim of Otis Shackelford, Individually and the Estate of Patsy Shackelford is eligible for reimbursement in the amount of \$8,500.00.

Payment of said amount is conditioned upon claimant complying with the subrogation assignment and other requirements of Sec. 6 of GOV. Rule VIII of the Ohio Supreme Court.

In Re Application of Kyle L. Ciminillo vs. Kenneth Levon Lawson
Claim No. 08-0046

This cause came on for hearing before the Board of Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund this **28th day of August, 2009** on the application of Kyle L. Ciminillo alleging a loss in the amount of \$10,000.00, caused by dishonest conduct of an attorney duly licensed to practice in the State of Ohio

The Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund of Ohio find that:

- a) An attorney client relationship did exist between the claimant and Kenneth Levon Lawson.
- b) The claimant suffered a loss of \$6,666.00 on or about May 1, 2007.

The Commissioners further find that the dishonest conduct consisted of settlement theft, and that the following disciplinary proceedings were taken:

Felony Suspension on 7/31/2009

The Commissioners further find that the claimant took affirmative action against the attorney within one year of becoming aware of the loss; and that there is no insurance or bond which will benefit the claimant; and that said claimant is not a spouse, close relative, partner, insurer or bonding company, nor a governmental unit.

Therefore the Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund do hereby determine that the claim of Kyle L. Ciminillo is eligible for reimbursement in the amount of \$6,666.00.

Payment of said amount is conditioned upon claimant complying with the subrogation assignment and other requirements of Sec. 6 of GOV. Rule VIII of the Ohio Supreme Court.


