PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against Robert Farinacci, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on September 11, 2009.

The Respondent was suspended from the practice of law on August 29, 2008, for noncompliance with the CLE requirements. While the Respondent's law license was suspended, the Respondent represented clients and filed pleadings in Bradley County Chancery Court and the Probate Division of Blount County General Sessions Court. The Respondent contacted the CLE Commission, complied with the CLE requirements, and paid the requisite fines and fees. On December 8, 2008, the Respondent's law license was returned to active status.


The Respondent states that he was not aware that his law license had been suspended until the Bradley County Chancery Court contacted him shortly after he filed a notice of appeal on behalf of a client on October 1, 2008. Upon learning of the suspension, the Respondent contacted his clients to make sure that their interests were protected.

While the Respondent's law license was suspended for noncompliance with the CLE

requirements, the Respondent continued to practice law by representing clients and filing pleadings.

By the aforementioned facts, Robert Farinacci, has violated Rule of Professional Conduct 5.5 and is hereby Publicly Censured for this violation.


