



CLAIM DETERMINATION ENTRY

In Re Application of Janan K. Tyson vs. Alexander Jurczenko  
Claim No. 08-0008

This cause came on for hearing before the Board of Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund this 28<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2009 on the application of Janan K. Tyson alleging a loss in the amount of \$150,000.00, caused by dishonest conduct of an attorney duly licensed to practice in the State of Ohio

The Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund of Ohio find that:

- a) An attorney client relationship did exist between the claimant's mother and Alexander Jurczenko.
- b) The claimant, along with her two brothers, suffered a total loss of \$1,000.00 on or about December, 2006.

The Commissioners further find that the dishonest conduct consisted of theft of unearned fees, and that the following disciplinary proceedings were taken:

DISBARRED on 7/25/2007

The Commissioners further find that the claimant took affirmative action against the attorney within one year of becoming aware of the loss; and that there is no insurance or bond which will benefit the claimant; and that said claimant is not a spouse, close relative, partner, insurer or bonding company, nor a governmental unit.

Therefore the Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund do hereby determine that the claim is eligible for reimbursement in the amount of \$1,000.00. The Commissioners determine further that \$500 shall be reimbursed to claimant Janan K. Tyson, \$250 to John Tyson, and \$250 to James Tyson.

Payment of said amount is conditioned upon claimants complying with the subrogation assignment and other requirements of Sec. 6 of GOV. Rule VIII of the Ohio Supreme Court.
