

Moreover, Respondent himself submits that he is the the main provider of care for his son who suffers from autism while his wife is at work during the day. Respondent filed a previous motion to stay proceedings on February 8, 2010 and that Motion is not yet ruled upon and was done with the cooperation of consent of counsel for both parties.

WHEREFORE then parties ask the Court to suspend the imposition of the current sentence or in the alternative, to suspend the remainder of the respondent's sentence as suggested in this Court's previous order based on his cooperation with the Relator.


WHEREFORE, Defendant and counsel prevail upon the Court to grant the Motion.
