
AGREED STIPULATION FOR  
EXTENSION OF TIME


The date set by the Supreme Court for Respondent, Kenneth Norman Shaw, to show cause why the recommendation of the Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline should not be confirmed by the Supreme Court is 20 days from the date of the Order to Show cause, or March 16, 2010.

Respondent has requested the consent of Mr. Robert Berger, Esq., Relator for the Disciplinary Counsel, for a 20 day extension to file a brief, and respondent is in the process of retaining Mr. Richard Koblentz of Koblentz Pendvos, LLC to assist him in preparing a brief and oral argument. Mr. Koblentz had a prior engagement through the 15<sup>th</sup> of March and would have been unable to represent Respondent without obtaining an extension. Mr. Berger has consented to the 20 day extension to file the brief.

With the agreement to the 20 day extension, the new due date for filing the brief would now be April 5, 2010.


