


CLAIM DETERMINATION ENTRY

In Re Application of Gary Armbruster v. Mark Dennis Schnitkey
Claim Number 08-0127

This cause came on for hearing before the Board of Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund this 5th day of March, 2010 on the application of Gary Armbruster alleging a loss in the amount of \$1,228, caused by dishonest conduct of an attorney duly licensed to practice in the State of Ohio

The Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund of Ohio find that:

- a) An attorney client relationship did exist between the claimant and Mark Dennis Schnitkey.
- b) The claimant suffered a loss of \$1,228 on or about September 13, 2007.

The Commissioners further find that the dishonest conduct consisted of theft of unearned fees, and that the following disciplinary proceedings were taken:

Resigned-Discipline Pending on 8/30/2007

The Commissioners further find that the claimant took affirmative action against the attorney within one year of becoming aware of the loss; and that there is no insurance or bond which will benefit the claimant; and that said claimant is not a spouse, close relative, partner, insurer or bonding company, nor a governmental unit.

Therefore the Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund do hereby determine that the claim of Gary Armbruster is eligible for reimbursement in the amount of \$1,228.

Payment of said amount is conditioned upon claimant complying with the subrogation assignment and other requirements of Sec. 6 of GOV. Rule VIII of the Ohio Supreme Court.
