

ORDER

It appearing to the Court that on March 23, 2010, an Order was entered in this proceeding directing respondent to show cause within 30 days why this Court should not impose identical discipline on him as heretofore imposed by the Supreme Court of Ohio; and no response having been filed with the Clerk of this Court;
