

MEMORANDUM

Pursuant to S. Ct. Prac. R. XI, Section 2, defendant has filed a motion for reconsideration of this Court's May 26, 2010, decision declining jurisdiction over his discretionary appeal. The State of Ohio opposes the motion and asserts that defendant has not set forth adequate reasons for reconsideration.


In fact, defendant's motion violates S. Ct. Prac. R. XI, Section 2(B) as it merely contains a "reargument of the case." In each of his eight claims for reconsideration, defendant reasserts the same arguments that were rejected by the Tenth District and by this Court. Nowhere does he claim any "obvious error" in this Court's May 26, 2010, decision refusing to grant jurisdiction. See App. R. 26(A). Indeed, his arguments do not even reference this Court's decision. Accordingly, reconsideration is inappropriate in this case.

CONCLUSION

The State of Ohio urges this Court to deny the motion for reconsideration.


