


MEMORANDUM

It is important that the record be clear and accurate regarding whether Respondent Stanley Jackson made payments of restitution on the Jamiel Robinson matter.

As the testimony of Mr. Jackson and perhaps others reflects, Mr. Jackson did make initial payments on the agreement. The response to the questions asked in the oral argument may have given the impression that absolutely no payments were made, as counsel for Respondent did not wish to infer that Respondent was in full compliance with the agreement.

As the testimony, as it exists before the Court, reflects what payments to Mr. Robinson have been made by Mr. Jackson, Respondent respectfully urges the Court to permit this important clarification.


