

**RELATOR'S RESPONSE
TO RESPONDENT'S
MOTION TO CLARIFY
RECORD, FILED ON
AUGUST 11, 2010**

Relator, Disciplinary Counsel, responds to Respondent's Motion to Clarify the Record concerning his counsel's statement during the August 10, 2010 oral argument about respondent's partial restitution payment to Jasiel (not Jamiel) Robinson. For the convenience of the Court, relator identifies the specific evidence concerning the amount of restitution received by Mr. Robinson from respondent in this matter.

At the hearing, the panel admitted into evidence a copy of a settlement agreement reached between respondent and Mr. Robinson as respondent's Exhibit A. (Hearing Tr., Vol. II at 714.) As stated in the settlement agreement, respondent promised to repay Mr. Robinson \$15,000, with an initial payment of \$1,000 followed by fourteen monthly installments of \$1,000. (Respondent's Ex. A.) In response to a question by respondent's counsel, Craig Morice, about the actual payment received, Mr. Robinson gave the following response.

- Q. And you are naturally aware of the fact that between you and Mr. Jackson as we sit here right now there is an agreement to repay \$15,000 and that he has made his initial payment pursuant to that agreement.

A. Yes sir.



Based on the above, relator submits that the record in this matter reflects that respondent has made a single restitution payment of \$1,000 to Mr. Robinson.


