Dear Mr. Potts:

On December 14, 1992, the Supreme Court of Ohio indefinitely suspended you from the practice of law. You were reinstated on December 18, 1996, and placed you on monitored probation. You were ordered to cooperate fully with a monitoring attorney appointed by relator. At the end of your probationary period, relator was ordered to file with the court a report stating whether you complied with the conditions of probation and monitoring.

On October 21, 2010, you filed an Application for Termination of Probation. The Supreme Court of Ohio has informed the Clerk's Office that it will not consider an attorney's application for termination of probation until the Court's orders and Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio have been fully complied with and the requirements for termination of probation have been met. Although the relator filed a notice of appointment of monitoring attorney on February 25, 1997, as of the date of this letter, the relator has not filed its report with the Court. The Court will not consider your termination of probation until such time as relator files this report with the Clerk's Office of the Supreme Court.
