
On December 30, 2008, the Supreme Court of Ohio suspended you from the practice of law for a period of one year, stayed the suspension and placed you on monitored probation. The Court's order (a copy of which is included with this letter) required you to pay the costs of publication as required by Gov.Bar R.V(8)(D)(2). Publication costs in the amount of \$293.94, were invoiced on July 24, 2009. The invoice (also included) noted that interest at the rate of 10% per annum would be charged if you did not pay the costs within 90 days.

On February 3, 2011, you filed an application for termination of probation. The Court will not consider your application for termination of probation until the publication costs plus interest are paid in full by certified check, cashier's check, or money order. If you wish to have the Clerk's Office calculate the amount of interest owed, please contact us at 614-387-9530. When calling, please refer to the case number listed above.

Additionally, you were ordered to cooperate fully with a monitoring attorney appointed by relator. At the end of your probationary period, relator was ordered to file with the court a report stating whether you complied with the conditions of probation and monitoring. The court will not consider an attorney's application for termination of probation until the Court's orders and Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio have been fully complied with and the requirements for termination of probation have been met. Although the relator filed a notice of appointment of monitoring attorney on January 13, 2009, as of the date of this letter, the relator has not filed its report with the Court. The Court will not consider your termination of probation

until such time as relator files this report with the Clerk's Office of the Supreme Court and you have paid the publication costs and accrued interest in full.
