Order of Reinstatement

This matter is before the court on Respondent Todd Austin Brenner's petition for reinstatement to practice law in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Ohio. Respondent was reinstated to practice law by the Ohio Supreme Court on September 2, 2010.

Counsel for the court has no opposition to the petition. Respondent's license to practice law in Ohio is currently in good standing, and there are no formal complaints pending against him. Counsel states that he has no testimony or other evidence upon which to oppose the petition.
