
Dear Mr. Marshall:

On May 9, 2011, Geoffrey Lynn Oglesby filed a Petition for Reinstatement with the Clerk's Office in the above-captioned case. On December 27, 2000, this court ordered that Mr. Oglesby be indefinitely suspended. On July 31, 2003, respondent filed a petition for reinstatement, which the court denied on May 10, 2004. On September 2, 2008, respondent filed a petition for reinstatement, which the court denied on May 7, 2009.

As required by Gov.Bar R.V(10)(D), a five hundred dollar deposit for costs accompanied Mr. Oglesby's Petition. This Petition appears to be sufficient in form and substance pursuant to the requirements of Gov.Bar R.V(10)(C). Five copies of the Petition are enclosed, in accordance with Gov.Bar R.V(10)(F).
