


BRIEF

With this motion, the parties jointly ask this Court to permit them to supplement the record with several transcripts that were included in the record below but were omitted from the lower court's certification of the record.

In the record on appeal, the Eighth District reviewed 10 transcript volumes from the following dates:

- April 6, 2005
- April 28, 2005
- June 15, 2005
- June 17, 2005
- January 5, 2007
- November 20, 2008
- December 23, 2008
- January 13, 2009
- February 9, 2010
- February 12, 2010

After the Eighth District affirmed the lower court's ruling, the transcripts were returned to the juvenile clerk on January 13, 2011.


J.V. filed an appeal with this Court on January 19, 2011. While J.V.'s jurisdictional memorandum was pending with this Court, his counsel was notified that, pursuant to court policy, he had 60 days to retrieve the transcripts or they would be destroyed. To avoid the destruction of the transcripts, counsel for J.V. took possession of them.

On May 25, 2011, this Court accepted J.V.'s appeal and ordered the clerk to certify the record. When the clerk transferred the record to this Court, it only included the three most recent transcripts: January 13, 2009, February 9, 2010, and February 12, 2010. The remaining 7 transcript volumes were not included because they had been turned over to J.V.'s counsel.

To ensure that this Court has the entire record that was before the Eighth District, the parties jointly request that they be permitted to supplement the record with the remaining seven transcript volumes.


