

**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

It has been shown to the Court that the Supreme Court of Ohio has suspended the above-name attorney from practice. Pursuant to Addendum Eight of the Rules of the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit, IT IS ORDERED that said attorney show cause why this Court should not discipline said attorney in the same manner.

Unless said attorney files a response within fourteen (14) days from the date of this order, showing cause why said attorney should not be disciplined in the same manner, said attorney shall be suspended from practice before this Court. If a response is filed, said attorney shall be suspended from the bar of this Court until this Court otherwise orders. See Rule 5.A. of Addendum Eight.
