Now comes the Respondent, Kevin Toohig, Pro Se, and respectfully requests This Honorable Court grant him an additional 20 days to file objections to THE FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ON GRIEVANCES AND DISCIPLINE OF THE SUPREME COURT OF OHIO. These objections and brief in support are currently due on Monday, January 2, 2012. For the reasons stated below, Respondent requests a 20 day extension until 1/23/12 or in the alternative a 10 day extension until 1/12/12 to file objections to the findings of the Board.

Respondent picked up This Court's Motion to Show Cause dated 12/13/11 on the first date he was notified he had certified mail and the post office was open for business.

This request is in compliance with The Supreme Court Rules of Practice and Rule V of The Rules Governing the Bar. There have been no previous requests for an extension of time.
