

MOTION TO ADMIT LAUREN S. KULEY *PRO HAC VICE*


Pursuant to Gov. Bar R. XII, § 2(A)(6) and S. Ct. Prac. R 1.2, the undersigned respectfully moves the Court for admission to appear on behalf of and represent *pro hac vice* Amicus Curiae the Attorney General of Ohio, in the above-captioned matter, stating the following grounds:

1. Movant is a Deputy Solicitor in the Ohio Attorney General's office, located at 30 East Broad Street, 17th Floor, Columbus, OH 43215.
2. Movant resides at 41 ½ West Third Ave, Columbus, OH 43201.


