On July 1, 2011, in Case Number 973029, an application for attorney fees was filed. Respondent was the attorney of record on the case at the time. The application included work which was completed after May 4, 2011. *See Exhibit B.*

On July 5, 2011, in Case Number 2007-003536, Respondent submitted a Fiduciary Account, which she signed as an attorney with her attorney registration number. *See Exhibit C.* On that same day, Respondent also filed an Application to Extend Administration, which she also signed as an attorney with her attorney registration number. *See Exhibit D.*

On August 2, 2011, in Case Number 990748, Respondent applied for attorney fees. Respondent was attorney of record in the case at the time of the filing. The application included fees for work completed after May 4, 2011. *See Exhibit E.* Additionally, Respondent signed an Entry Setting Hearing on Account as an attorney with her attorney registration number. *See Exhibit F.*

On August 3, 2011, in Case Number 2006-005535, Respondent filed a Guardian's Report, which she signed as an attorney with her attorney registration number. *See Exhibit G.*

On September 12, 2011, in Case Number 2010-002414, Respondent filed a Fiduciary Account, which she signed as an attorney with her registration number. *See Exhibit H.* On that same day, Respondent also signed an Entry Setting Hearing on Account as an attorney. *See Exhibit I.*

On October 3, 2011, in Case Number 2010-000487, Respondent was served with a notice of an overdue account. *See Exhibit J.* Despite Respondent's retired status, she was listed as the attorney handling the case.


On or about October 5, 2011, the Chief Magistrate at the Hamilton County Probate Court discovered Respondent's retired status. The Chief Magistrate removed Respondent from the cases on which she was counsel of record and substituted counsel. Respondent had failed to withdraw from the cases on which she was counsel of record. *See Exhibit K.* Identical orders removing Respondent were entered in 24 additional cases in the Hamilton County Probate Court. *See Exhibit L.*

Wherefore, based upon the foregoing, Relator hereby moves the Supreme Court of Ohio to find Respondent in contempt for continuing to practice law, despite taking retired status, and to enter such an order as it finds proper.
