
The Supreme Court of Ohio will hold an oral argument on the merits in this case on Wednesday, April 25, 2012, at the Marion County Courthouse, in Judge Davidson's Courtroom, 100 North Main Street, Marion, Ohio 43302-3089. Time allowed for oral argument will be 15 minutes per side.

Attorneys who argue before the court must comply with the provisions of Rule 9.2 through 9.5 of the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and the instructions that follow. Pursuant to Rule 9.3, counsel for either or both parties may waive oral argument and submit the case upon briefs. The Clerk must be notified in writing of the waiver at least seven days before the date scheduled for the oral argument.

Court convenes promptly at 9 a.m. Counsel in all cases are expected to be present when court convenes. Counsel must register with the Court Marshal **prior to 8:45 a.m.** on the 3rd Floor, outside of the courtroom, Marion County Courthouse.
