Request to Extend Time to File the Trial Court Transcript

The notice of appeal was filed in this death penalty case on November 30, 2011. Pursuant to a request by the court reporter, one extension of time has been requested and approved by this Court. The record is currently due on April 30, 2012.

Counsel for Mr. Dean has been in contact with the court reporter, Ms. Judith Pierce concerning the preparation of the transcript. Ms. Pierce estimates that the transcript of this trial is approximately 2700 pages in length. Due to her backlog of transcripts to prepare as well as her continued involvement in ongoing trials, she has not been able to complete the Dean transcript. In addition, she has suffered two deaths in her family, requiring out of town travel. According to her affidavit, attached, she is in need of an additional 60 days to complete the transcript.

Wherefore, pursuant to S.Ct. Prac. Rule 19.5(C), Appellant Dean requests an additional sixty days, to June 29, 2012 to prepare and file the transcript of proceedings, as a part of the record in this case.






I, Judith L. Pierce, certify that I am legally competent, over the age of 18, and swear that the following is true to the best of my personal knowledge:
