Now comes the Relator-Appellant, Dr. Terrie Sizemore RN DVM, and respectfully makes formal and legal request for reconsideration of the June 21, 2012 Judgment Entry. Dr. Sizemore respectfully states she cannot determine a legal basis for this decision as well as she cannot determine and conclusions of law to support the decision or findings of fact consistent with the facts of this appeal.


Relator-Appellant, Dr. Sizemore, is aware of the Rules promulgated by this Court requiring all Courts to provide the above information to all parties participating in a legal action. She contends this decision is vague and ambiguous and she does not understand what is meant by 'was considered in the manner prescribed by law.' Dr. Sizemore requests clarification of what this means because she contends her entire legal argument has been unaddressed and this Court appears to ignore its own prior decisions which constitute law and legal basis for argument provided by this Appellant.

Dr. Sizemore requests the legal basis for denying her Writ of Mandamus and finding the OVMLB in contempt of the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas ORDER to re-issue an Order in compliance with RC 119.09. Dr. Sizemore requests legal basis for denying her the fifteen days this Supreme Court of Ohio stated by law she is entitled to. Dr. Sizemore requests legal basis to support the conflicting decisions below as well as the legal basis for the Courts below ignoring the doctrine of stare decisis as well as ignoring the Administrative Appeal Act requiring the exhaustion of all administrative remedies. Please provide legal basis and conclusions of law for all points addressed in the merit brief and reply brief of Appellant, Dr. Sizemore.

Dr. Sizemore asserts she cannot find a legal conclusion or legal rationale or findings of fact that are consistent with the facts of this case and therefore respectfully requests


