
{¶2} The panel finds that this agreement conforms to BCGD Proc. Reg. 11 and the undersigned members recommend acceptance of the agreement including the stipulated facts, affidavit of Respondent, and stipulated violations of Prof. Cond. R. 1.3, Prof. Cond. R. 1.4, Prof. Cond. R. 1.15(a), Prof. Cond. R. 1.5(d)(3), Prof. Cond. R. 1.15(c), Prof. Cond. R. 1.15(d), and Prof. Cond. R. 8.4. The panel concurs in the agreed sanction of a public reprimand. In addition, as of the time of the filing of this report, the panel chair was advised by Relator that Respondent made restitution to the client in the amount of \$1,500.
