

Now comes the Defendant-Appellant, Steven W. Yee, propria persona and with assistance and his supplementation with recent authority issued out of the Ohio Supreme Court, pursuant to the Ohio and United States Constitutions, instanter.

On November 29th, 2012, this Court rendered the decision of State v. Moore, 2012 Ohio LEXIS 2911 (affirmed), at (¶14)("It is a long-standing principle that an offender's sentence that does not properly include a statutorily mandated term is contrary to law").

This decision supports the issues raised in the Memorandum in Support of Jurisdiction, Proposition of Law 1, 2 and pending Reconsideration motion.

Wherefore, the appellant prays the Court finds this well taken.
